

# Inside the Visitor Centre Building - First Floor

There are several ways to reach the first floor of the visitor centre building. From the reception area on the ground floor you can take the lift which is directly opposite the main entrance. To the left of the lift there is a flight of stairs. If you visit the Cliffs Exhibition the ramp runs from the ground floor entrance to the first floor, passing the first floor entry to the lift on the way. From outside the centre there is a path that leads from the first floor exit to the cliff edge and it is also possible to come back into the visitor centre via this pathway.

On the first floor you will find more toilets and the Cliffs View Café. The Café has 100 seats and windows that provide a panoramic view over the Cliffs and Liscannor Bay. In the Café you can get homemade soups and quiches, hot meals, desserts, hot drinks and lots more. The Café uses lots of local ingredients and can provide vegetarian, gluten free and other dishes for special dietary requirements. It is a great place to enjoy lunch or a snack after a visit to the Cliffs and family members who do not want to walk too far can relax there while waiting for the more energetic members of the group.



The Cliffs View Café is very busy at lunchtimes during the summer and seating is on a first come first served basis.
